

BACKGROUND

BDH1 (3-hydroxybutyrate dehydrogenase, type 1) is a member of the short-chain dehydrogenase/reductase family. This protein forms a homotetrameric lipid-requiring enzyme of the mitochondrial membrane and has a specific requirement for phosphatidylcholine for optimal enzymatic activity. It catalyzes the interconversion of acetoacetate and (R)-3-hydroxybutyrate, the two major ketone bodies produced during fatty acid catabolism.¹

Source

BDH1 Antibody is a mouse monoclonal antibody raised against purified recombinant human BDH1-Fc fusion protein expressed in 293 cells.

Specificity and Sensitivity:

This antibody detects endogenous BDH1 proteins in normal cell lysates without cross-reactivity with other related proteins.

Storage Buffer: PBS and 30% glycerol


Storage:


Store at -20°C for at least one year. Store at 4°C for frequent use. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
